Some States have recently addressed letters to the president of the Security Council requesting a cease-fire in Libya, while all those States know that the Operative Paragraph (1) of Security Council resolution 1973 states:

“Demands the immediate establishment of a cease-fire and a complete end to violence and all attacks against, and abuses of, civilians;”

However, Qadhafi regime continued to attack residential areas in the cities with tanks and Russian-made Grad rockets, from long distance, after imposing siege on the cities, cutting off electricity, water and communications, prohibiting the delivery of food and medication to the residents, limiting the capacity of hospitals and preventing the supply of medications and medical equipments.

The assassinations and rape crimes perpetrated and still being perpetrated by Qadhafi’s brigades and mercenaries in the cities of Zawiya and Misurata, and some other cities of the Western Mount such as Az-Zintan, Nalut, Kapaow and Kkkla, are crimes against humanity aiming to revenge from the Libyan people who are rejecting to live under Qadhafi’s rule, by destroying as much of the Libyan cities as possible and killing as many Libyans as possible before stepping down, which is eventually near as confirmed by Musa Kusa, the former Foreign Minister of Libya in his phone call with Ambassador Abdurrahman Shalgham, from London on Saturday afternoon on 02 April 2011 who said: “In my last phone call with Muamar Qadhafi before leaving Tripoli, I felt that he is 100 times more dangerous than Hitler, he is a lunatic malevolent with a huge arsenal of arms and big numbers of mercenaries, and he is trying to destroy the country and eliminate the Libyan people as he is planning to ignite a long-term civil war similar to that in Somalia”.

The situation in Libya is terrible, and it is hard to deal with Qadhafi humanly since he has no molecule of mercy and morals as we are all witnessing how his brigades deal with the detainees and how they shoot and kill whoever does not cheer with the life of Qadhafi.

How could anyone hold a dialogue with this criminal who calls himself “Glory” and calls his peoples “Rats”? How could anyone talk about a peaceful solution while Qadhafi rejects any solution that does not include him staying in power?? How could anyone talk about a peaceful solution while his brigades and mercenaries are bombarding cities with heavy weaponry, imposing siege on people in their houses, strafing the residences in Tripoli and Zawiya, detaining men and raping women? How could anyone talk with this butcher who affirmed in all of his recent speeches that he will liquidate all those rejecting his rule? How could anyone deal with this boastful selfish who says he paid a price for Libya meaning he owns it with his family?

The question of cease-fire is a matter for Col. Qadhafi. He is the one who is still attacking the civilians, therefore; he should stop that immediately and withdraw his brigades and mercenaries from the Libyan cities and locate them back to their bases and subject to the will of the Libyan people. By not doing so, it is the responsibility of the international community to compel him to do that, pursuant to the resolutions of the Security Council 1970 and 1973. Any tolerance with Qadhafi will be seen by the Libyan people as an attempt to prolong the life of Qadhafi regime and encourage the partitioning of Libya which are both rejected by the Libyan people who will carry weapons to fail that. The presence of Qadhafi on the top of power in Libya constitutes a danger on the life of the civilians; therefore, he should leave power immediately.
